The black mafia family was founded in 1989 south-west of Detroit by the Demetrius brothers "Big Meech" Flenory and Terry "Southwest T" Flenory, and since 2000 had established cocaine sales in all the United States through their Los Angeles drug source and direct connections with Mexican drug cartels[2][3] The black mafia family operated from two main hubs: one in Atlanta for the distribution managed by Demetrius Flenory and one in Los Angeles to manage the shipments coming from Mexico managed by Terry Flenory.[4] The black mafia family under Demetrius Flenory entered hip-hop business as BMF Entertainment in the early 2000s as a façade organization to recycle money from cocaine sales and legitimize. BMF Entertainment has been the promoter of several high-profile hip-hop artists, including Young Jeezy, and as a record label for their only artist at Bleu DaVinci. Demetrius Flenory and the black mafia family became famous in the popular hip-hop culture for their extremely extravagant lifestyles. In 2005, the anti-drug administration (DEA) accused members of the black mafia family, ultimately ensuring the convictions for targeting the Flenory brothers under the statute of criminal enterprises in continuous, and both were sentenced to thirty years of imprisonment. Prosecutors said that the black mafia family made over \$270 million during their operations.[5] The Flenorys Demetrius Edward "Big Meech" Flenory (born June 21, 1968, in Detroit, Michigan) and his brother Terry P.O. Lee "Southwest T" Flenory (born January 10, 1970, in Detroit, Michigan) began selling \$50 cocaine bags at the end of the streets of Detroit. For 2000, the Flenory brothers had established a large organization that overseed multi-kilogramme cocaine sales in several United States, including Alabama, California, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, North Carolina, Ohio and Tennessee.[8] A two-year federal investigation of the Flenory organization estimated its membership of more than 500. Around 2001, the organization had a schism when the Flenory brothers started feuding, while Terry Flenory moved to Los Angeles to direct his organization, while Demetrius Flenory remained in the main distribution center of Atlanta. During a conversation with his brothers captured by the DEA in interception, Terry discussed his concerns about the fact that his brother Demetrius was bringing the wrong attention to their business with his excessive party. When charges were filed against the Flenory, the government had 900of transcripts of conversations intercepted by Terry's phone in a period of five months.[8] In November 2007, the brothers begged for prayerto run an ongoing criminal enterprise. [9] In September 2008, both brothers were sentenced to 30 years in prison for carrying out a nationwide cocaine ring, which lasted from 2000 to 2005. [10] Demetrius Flenory is serving his sentence at the Federal Correctional Institution, Sheridan and is scheduled for release on May 5, 2032, around his 64th birthday. [11] During his incarceration at the United States Penitentiary, Lompoc, a federal medium-security prison in California, adopted the name Big Herm. Terry Flenory was released at home on May 5, 2020, after being granted a compassionate release due to health problems and an effort by the Federal Bureau of Prisons to release some inmates in order to limit the spread of the COVID-19 pandemic within federal prisons. Demetrius Flenory also sought his release under the same guidelines; however, a federal judge dismissed the move, arguing that it would be premature to authorize his release as his prison record suggests he has not changed and continues to promote himself as a drug repertory, further stating his disciplinary record includes violations such as possession of a cell phone and weapons, as well as drug use. In the early 2000s, Demetrius Flenory founded BMF Entertainment as a promotion agency and record label for hip-hop music. The Flenory brothers were already known for associating with several high-profile hip-hop artists including Trina, T.I., Shawty Lo, Jay-Z and Fabolous. Demetrius founded BMF Entertainment as a front organization for money laundering of the money generated by the cocaine distribution network, but it was also an attempt to create a legitimate source of income and legal business. Around this time, the Flenory organization formally adopted the name "Family of the Black Mafia" after being previously unnamed. In 2005, Bleu Da Vinci's album, World Is BMF's, was nominated for a Source Award. BMF has appeared in numerous underground hip-hop DVD magazines, notably several issues of S.M.A.C.K. and The Come Up. The most visible aspect of the organization was a full-length DVD produced by Raw Report, which took a detailed look at their movement. The DVD featured the Vibe cover article on BMF in May 2006. He received wide acclaim from DJs for Soundsmith Productions and produced the song "Streets on Lock",[13] directed by BMF's Bleu Davinci subsidiary and featuring Fabolous and Young Jeezy. A music video[14] was then produced for the single, although it was never released to networks. Creative Loafing Senior Editor Mara Shalhoup wrote a three-part series about the black mafia family titled Hip-Hop's Shadowy Empire.[15] which was the first in-depth report Shalhoup's book on organization, BMF: The Rise and Fall of Big Meech and the Black Mafia Family, was published in March 2010. Police investigations into the Black Mafia began in the early 1990s, before the organization run by Demetrius and Terry Flenory was named or reached maximum publicity. Preparations for the October 2005 indictments began with a series of large-scale drug seizures and subsequent informant testimonies by members of the BMF. On October 28, 2003, a two-year investigation by the Task Force on Drug Enforcement against Organized Crime, coordinated by the DEA Special Operations Division and codenamed "Operation Motor City Mafia", began. On April 11, 2004, BMF courier and senior distributor Jabari Hayes was arrested in the county, from Phelps, Missouri, on I-44 driving a 40-foot RV, presumably BMF also received drugs through large containers at the airport containing 100's, 150-pound cocaine, which they collected and delivered to the warehouses.[16] The Range Rover after a K-9 unit had reported drugs in the vehicle.[8] In mid-September 2004, an interception of Rafael "Smurf" Allison, a crack dealer, low-level drug dealer in Atlanta, he brought a HIDTA task force to Decarlo Hoskins, a mid-level drug dealer. Hoskins told them he grew up with two brothers, Omari McCree and Jeffrey Leahr, members of the BMF and able to provide regular amounts of multi-kg cocaine. Wiretaps revealed that Omari McCree was the top-level distributor for the Flenory organization and was favored by Demetrius. On November 5, 2004, Jeffrey Leahr was stopped with his girlfriend on I-75 in Atlanta due to wiretaps. In the backseat was a bag containing 10 kilos of cocaine. They were released later that day in HIDTA's attempt to gather more information about their supplier and the organization using wiretaps. McCree and Leahr, faced with a huge debt to the BMF for the lost cocaine, fled. When he was arrested on June 8, 2005, Unknown signed a confidential agreement and described his role in the BMF, naming Demetrius Flenory as the source of the cocaine. Chad "J-Bo" Brown, supplied him with cocaine on behalf of Demetrius. These events and a number of others formed the backbone of the government's case. During the trial, the government's key witness was William "Doc" Marshall.[8] Testimonies given during various trials say that the Flenory organization did the following: BMF operated five hiding places in the Atlanta area. Approximately every 10 days, the vehicles arrived with 100k150 kg of cocaine packed in secret compartments. The hideout workers were paid to unload the drugs and store them.[16] Customers who ordered them called and said they had their vehicle ready, which was a means of transport to put the narcotics in. A Of the size of their order, they were directed to a particular hideout where they would pull over, enter, and deliver money in \$5,000 packages. Cocaine was usually sold for \$20,000 a kilogram.[16] The same vehicles would then be filled with money. (the proceeds of drug drugs To be sent back to Mexican sources of supply.[17] Workers inside the shelters had some duties, such as counting the masses of money, usually in millions. Other people were packing cocaine for their clients. BMF also received drugs through large containers at the airport containing 100's, 150-pound cocaine, which they collected and delivered to the warehouses.[16] raids and arrests Money seized by BMF by the Drug Enforcement Administration. Demetrius Flenory under arrest in 2005. In October 2005, it was reported that some 30-members of the BMF were arrested in a massive DEA-orchestrated drug raid. During these raids, the DEA seized \$3 million in cash and in assets, 2.5 kilograms of cocaine and numerous weapons.[18] Before the raids of October 2005, the DEA had arrested members of the 17-BMF, seized 633 kilograms of cocaine, \$5.3 million in cash, and \$5.7 million in assets. They said BMF was responsible for moving two,500 kilograms of cocaine a month across the United States. Demetrius Flenory and Terry Flenory have been charged under the Statute of Continuing Criminal Enterprises, conspiracy to distribute five kilograms or more cocaine, possession with the intent to distribute more than 500th 160's; grams of cocaine, conspiracy to launder money instruments, and two heads of possession with the intent to distribute more than five kilograms of cocaine. Demetrius was captured in a large house in a suburb outside Dallas. Inside, police found a small amount of marijuana and some MDMA pills. In a safe inside the house there were different weapons as well as different vehicles at home. Terry was captured in St. Louis with small amounts of marijuana and weapons found throughout the house, which was also occupied by several people at the time of the arrest. 2006, indictment in June 15, 2006, the US Treasury Department reported that sixteen other individuals had been charged with conspiracy to distribute cocaine and money laundering charges under a second, replacing the charge, bringing the number of people indicted in the case to 49. The list of accused included Jacob Arabo, commonly known as Jacob the Jeweler, a well-known jeweller famous in the hip-hop community. Arab has been accused of conspiracy to recycle more than \$270 million in illegally obtained funds.[19] The Justice Department has also shed light on more of the group's alleged activities in indictments, which included the management of drug money through various banks and money-laundering services in an attempt to disguise its origin. The group had also been accused of having obtained several winning Michigan State lottery tickets from a third party, for which they paid in cash, and then cashing in the in an attempt to make the legitimate money appear. The prosecution requested the confiscation of "more than thirty pieces of jewelry, thirteen residences, 35 vehicles, including Lincoln Limousine, BMW, Range Rovers, Aston-Martin, and Bentley, numerous bank accounts, over \$1.2 million in seized seized seized a total monetary judgment \$270 million. "f201 2007 incrimination On July 25, 2007, David Nahmias, the U.S. District Court prosecutor for the North District of Georgia filed an act of prosecution to 16 more members of the Black Mafia family.[21] The prosecution accused all defendants of participating in the national conspiracy for the distribution of cocaine, which entails a penalty in ten years and life in prison, and up to a million fines. Daniels. The month of July 26, 2007, the prosecution publishes sixteen BMF members in Atlanta with conspiracy to distribute cocaine. All the sixteen defendants, including Kamron Coleman, were accused of participating in the general conspiracy to distribute cocaine. The conspiracy charge provides for a minimum sentence of ten years in prison and a maximum sentence of life in prison, as well as a fine of \$4,000,000,000. In the end, all defendants were guilty before the trial except for Fleming "Ill" Daniels. Fleming Daniels, a prominent member of the Black Mafia Family, was sentenced to 20 years in prison for drug trafficking in December 17, 2008. The federal judge also fined Daniels \$10,000 for taking part in the violent group. Daniels was the 16th defendant charged in Atlanta for charges resulting from their role in the organization and the only defendant in the Atlanta prosecution to go to the trial, while eleven others had already been guilty.[22] The government case was based on William Marshall and Ralph Simms' testimony to condemn Daniels. Daniels had not been taken with cocaine, nor caught in interceptions talking about drug trafficking. Marshall's testimony indicated that he had seen Daniels receive cocaine in the kilograms as he was collecting cocaine.[22] Daniels also waited for the trial for the July 2004 murder of Rashaanibal Drummond. In February 26, 2010, he pleaded guilty and was sentenced to 20 years for voluntary murder. His 20-year sentence will be executed at the same time as another 20-year sentence, which will be pronounced for his role on the charges of cocaine of BMF. Barima "Bleu DaVinci" McKnight, the rapper and the only artist of BMF Entertainment, was sentenced to October 30, 2008, five years and four months in federal prison. McKnight claimed that Flenory was involved in the music industry and was only much later that he entered the cocaine side of the company.[22] McKnight stated to the judgment that when he met Demetrius Flenory, he did not show him "the other side of his world", referring to cocaine traffic. McKnight was released in 2011 and returned to his musical career. He and his younger brother Calico Jonez started the BMF tour. Calico Jonez, who had started Swishgang joined McKnight fora BMF Swishgang. Jonez, who was known for playing a role on Soulja Boy's SODMG label, and gang ties to Long Beach California's California's 20s Crips started making music under the BMF Entertainment umbrella. McKnight is also a cousin of Ras Kass. The last remaining suspect, Vernon Marcus Coleman, was arrested on July 17, 2009, in Atlanta. He was charged in 2007 with possession of drugs with intent to distribute cocaine. As of 2015, all indicted members of BMF have been arrested. However, the total number of BMF members exceeded well over 150. The federal government believes that the 150 they have indicted and arrested represent the command and control structure, as well as other key figures in the organization, such as distributors, warehouse operators, and transporters.[23] complaints of violence prior to Operation Motor City Mafia and shortly after its inception, there have been numerous alleged acts of violence by police officers. BMF members:[16] November 11, 2003: Demetrius Flenory was arrested in connection with the shooting in the Buckhead area at the Chaos Club of Anthony "Wolf" Jones, former bodyguard of Fr. Diddy, and Wolf's childhood friend Lamont "Riz" Girady. Anyway, Demetrius got shot in the buttocks and said he was running away from the shooting. He was never charged.[16] July 25, 2004: At a Midtown Atlanta club called the Velvet Room, a man named Rashaanibal "Prince" Drummond was killed. The accident began after Flemming "Ill" Daniels, almost returning to Drummond in his Porsche Cayenne Turbo. After Drummond hit the car to warn the driver, the passengers of the car got out and started beating Drummond and his friends. During the fight, a friend of Drummond fired a warning shot to scare everyone. Daniels retrieved the gun, returned fire, then went to Drummond and killed him on the ground.[16] September 2004: Ulysses Hackett and his girlfriend Misty Carter were executed in their Highland Avenue apartment in Atlanta. Police say the murders were ordered by Tremayne "Kiki" Graham, later son-in-law of Shirley Franklin, the mayor of Atlanta, and alleged BMF associate. They said Ulysses was thinking of testifying against BMF and Graham, becoming suspicious, ordering their murder.[16] May 10, 2005: Henry "Pookie Loc" Clark was killed by popular rapper Gucci Mane during an attempted robbery by Clark and four other men. The five men attacked Gucci Mane in the apartment of a stripper whom he met earlier, but Gucci Mane was armed and managed to shoot the attackers, hitting Clark. The incident occurred during a feud between Gucci Mane and rapper Young Jeezy, a good friend of Demetrius Flenory. Gucci Mane was later cleared of self-defense murder charges, and his lawyers claimed the five men had been ordered by the BMF to commit the robbery.[16] May 11, 2005: A fugitive named Deron Gatling was from a regional drug task force in Chamblee, Georgia. Task Force agents found collected behind the isolation at the attic: At that time, shots were fired from the outside of the law enforcement house. They tracked the last oneGatling's phone rang Jerry Davis, head of the alleged sister organization of BMF, the Sin City mob. The police said Gatling called Davis to report the officers at his home, and Davis ordered the shots fired.[16] May 23, 2005: Shayne and Kelsey Brown, the grandchildren of R&B singer Bobby Brown, were stabbed in the neck with an ice pick at Justin's birthday party, a restaurant in Atlanta owned by P. Diddy. Witnesses claim that Marque "Baby Bleu" Dixon, the younger brother of rap artist BMF and member Bleu DaVinci, had an altercation with the Browns next to the bodyguards of rapper Fabolous, who was there with Dixon. During the altercation, Dixon was accused of stabbing both of them in the neck, causing permanent deformity. Dixon was later murdered in 2006 by his girlfriend.[16] In popular culture Jabari Hayes, an alleged BMF member who supposedly served as a courier and distributor, wrote the book Miles in life (2009)[24] and is also the executive producer of a 2017 documentary with the same name. In both, Hayes tells her education in public housing in Brooklyn with a drug addict mother and a transfer to St. Louis as a high school to escape from her surroundings, finally landing in Atlanta where after graduating from Morehouse College, He started managing a parking lot that eventually led to his alleged involvement with BMF. Demetrius Flenory was interviewed from prison by Don Diva and The Source magazines.[26] In 2021, a dramatic television series called the Black Mafia Family premiere on STARZ. It was performed by Curtis "50 Cent" Jackson.
